

Hunting with Peak View Outfitters!

We are located on the west side of the continental divide at the west side of the Medicine Bow National Forest along the Little Snake River Valley. The Colorado border is just to our south about 2 miles. Early fall temperatures run from 25- 65. Evenings with mild days. Later fall temperatures from October – December prepare for temperatures ranging from 0-45. Snow is possible as well as rain. Usually, it's comfortable, but weather can change at any time. Layered clothing is recommended.

Bring a positive attitude and be physically and mentally prepared. Not everyone gets an opportunity at an animal the first day. The more prepared you are the better your success will be. The people that practice the most avoid missed shots. Be familiar with your weapon! Practice as much as you can. Shots for archery are generally 10 to 30 yards and rifle on average are 150 yards. Practice up to 300!
